Roma Store Sale

Roma heavy steers hit 202c/kg

A total of 3851 head of cattle were penned at Roma's Store Sale recently.

Feeder steers in the 400-550kg range topping at 202c/kg and averaging 188c/kg, while steers in the 350-400kg range reached 200c/kg and averaged 184c/kg and steers in the 280-350kg range reached 218c/kg and averaged 197c/kg. Weaner steers in the 220-280kg range reached 228c/kg and averaged 193c/kg, while weaners under 220kg topped at 216c/kg and averaged 196c/kg.

Institutional Investments, Toarki, Roma, sold Brangus-cross steers to 216c for 336kg to return \$727. They also sold Cross Bred heifers to 185c for 299kg to make \$553.

Roma Prime Sale

Roma bullocks hit 198c/kg

A total of 1356 head of cattle were penned at Roma's Prime Sale. Good lines of younger, local bullocks were yarded, plus more than usual bulls were penned. Quality of the yarding ranged from good quality crop-fed sorts to very plain conditioned cattle.

Steers over 550kg topped at 198c/kg and averaged 185c/kg, while steers in the 400-550kg sold to 195c/kg and averaged 181c/kg.

The Price family, Mt Hope, Wallumbilla, sold Droughtmaster steers to 198c for 568kg to return \$1127.

The Mulcahy family, Pringle Downs, Roma, sold Cross Bred steers to 195c and averaged 193c for 575kg to make \$1113.
